

I Like Bananas – Classroom Activity

Teacher Instructions



1. Ask your students to sit in a circle for the game.
2. A person starts the game by stating a fruit that they like.
3. The person next to them repeats the statement if they share the opinion, and so on. If a person does not like the named fruit then they say, "I don't like ... , I like ...", completing the statement with a fruit they do like.
4. The game continues in this way until a fruit is found that is liked by all, or not as the case may well be! This illustrates the range of normality to the children. We may have tastes in common, or do not – and that is completely normal.
